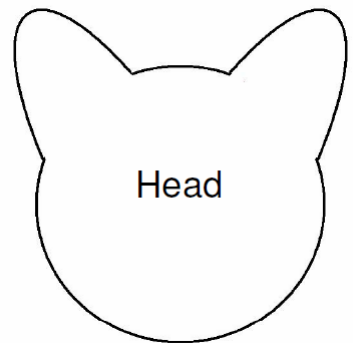




Toilet roll bat

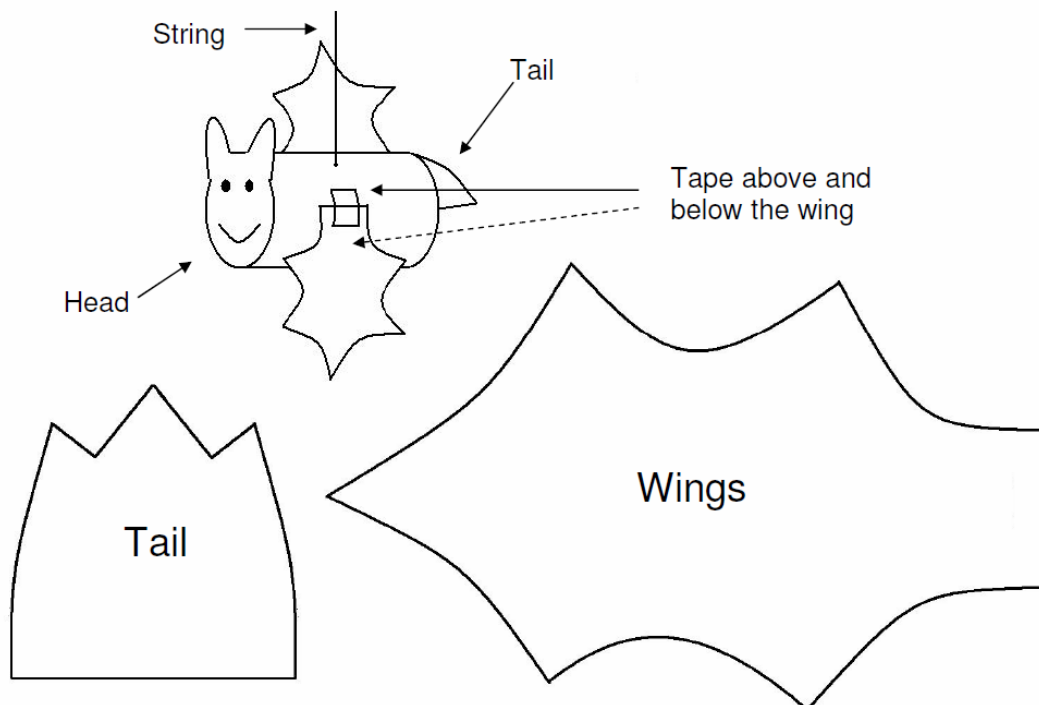
YOU WILL NEED

- A toilet roll
- Thin card (for example an old cereal box)
- Paint and paint brush
- Sticky tape
- String
- Glue



METHOD

- Paint your toilet roll body the colour of your choice, leave it to dry.
- Use the shapes provided to draw round and cut out carefully.
You will need two wings, one head and one tail.
- Paint the wings, head and tail and wait for them to dry.
- Glue the head to one end of the toilet roll, stand it upside down whilst it dries.
- Stick the wings to the side of the body with sticky tape above and below the wing.
Stick the tail to the inside of the tube.
- Ask an adult to help you put a little hole in the bat's back and tie a string through the bats body.
- Hang your bat up. Why not make a whole colony of bats?
