



Open areas

Many bats will often avoid flying over large, open areas. Where open areas are surrounded by trees or large hedges this sheltered 'edge' habitat can often be a great place to see bats hunting, especially if there is long grass or wildflowers attracting more insects.



What to look out for?

Pipistrelle bats can be found in most habitats, including open areas close to a woodland edge. They appear fast and jerky in flight as they dodge about pursuing small insects, which the bats catch and eat in flight.
