Street lights and other lighting can be an issue for many species of bats. Light shining on to roost exits can be especially bad for bats as it can affect what time they come out. However, bats like noctules, Leisler's, serotine and pipistrelle bats can be found feeding around some street lights.



What to look out for?

Spot small flying pipistrelles as you take a walk around your neighbourhood in the evening. They have an erratic flight and can be seen making twists and turns around buildings, streetlights and trees as they feed or fly off into the distance.
